



Health, Safety and Insurance

With regard to your health and safety requirements when visiting Cadbury World, we do not provide risk assessments to schools, or complete health and safety contracts or questionnaires. We would like to assure you that Cadbury World complies with relevant health, safety and environmental legislation.

- ◆ Cadbury World complies with relevant health and safety statutory legislation including the Health and Safety at Work Act etc 1974 and the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999.
- ◆ Staff who are qualified in first aid are always on duty and have access to the emergency services.
- ◆ Cadbury World public liability insurance, is provided as part of the Mondelez International global insurance arrangements and carries an indemnity limit of at least \$5M.

The Department for Education and Employment recommend in its good practice guide 'Health and Safety of Pupils on Educational Visits' that:

- ◆ The group leader should undertake and complete a comprehensive risk assessment. (Section 24)
- ◆ Risk assessments are usually carried out by the group leader. An assessment should be completed well before the visit, and should be approved by the head teacher. (Section 37)
